<p>He shall be a prophet</p>	<p>"I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren like you, and will put My words in his mouth, and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him." Deuteronomy 18:18</p>	<p>"And the multitudes were saying, 'This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth on Galilee.'" Matthew 21:11</p>
<p>He shall be a priest</p>	<p>"The Lord has sworn and will not change His mind, 'Thou art a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.'" <p>He shall be a judge</p>	<p>"For the Lord is our judge, the Lord is our Lawgiver, the Lord is our King; He will save us..." Isaiah 33:22</p>	<p>"I can do nothing on my own initiative, as I hear, I judge and My judgment is just, because I do not seek My own will but the will of Him who sent me." John 5:30</p>
<p>He shall be a King</p>	<p>"But as for Me, I have installed My King upon Zion, My holy mountain." Psalm 2:6</p>	<p>"And they put above His head the charge against Him which read, 'This is Jesus the King of the Jews'" Matthew 27:37</p>

<p>He shall be anointed of the Holy Spirit</p>	<p>"And the Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and strength, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord." Isaiah 11:2</p>	<p>"And after being baptized, Jesus went up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and He saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove, and coming upon Him; and behold a voice out of the heavens saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." Matthew 3:16-17</p>
<p>He will perform miracles</p>	<p>Then the eyes of the blind will be opened, and the ears of the deaf will be unstopped, then the lame will leap like a deer, and the tongue of the dumb will shout for joy. Isaiah 35:5,6</p>	<p>And Jesus was going about all the cities and the villages teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness. Matthew 9:35</p>
<p>He will teach parables</p>	<p>I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings of old. Psalms 78:2</p>	<p>All these things Jesus spoke to the multitudes in parables, and He was not talking to them without a parable. Matthew 13:34</p>
<p>He would be betrayed by a friend</p>	<p>Even my close friend, in whom I trusted, who ate my bread, has lifted up his heel against me. Psalms 41:9</p>	<p>Judas Iscariot, the one who betrayed Him. Matthew 10:4</p>
<p>He would be sold for 30 pieces of silver</p>	<p>And I said to them, "if it is good in your sight, give me my wages; but if not, never mind!" So they weighed out thirty shekels of silver as my wages. Zechariah 11:12</p>	<p>"What are you willing to give me to deliver Him up to you?" And they weighed out to him thirty pieces of silver. Matthew 26:15</p>
<p>The money would be thrown in God's house</p>	<p>"..so I took the thirty shekels of silver and threw them to the potter in the house of the Lord." Zechariah 11:13b</p>	<p>And he threw the pieces of silver into the sanctuary and departed... Matthew 27:5a</p>

<p>He would be forsaken by his disciples</p>	<p>...strike the shepherd that the sheep may be scattered... Zechariah 13:7</p>	<p>And they all left Him and fled. Mark 14:50</p>
<p>He would be accused by false witnesses</p>	<p>Malicious witnesses rise up; they ask me of things that I do not know. Psalms 35:11</p>	<p>Now the chief priests and the whole council kept trying to obtain false testimony against Jesus, in order that they might put Him to death; and they did not find it, even though many false witnesses came forward. Matthew 26:59-61</p>
<p>He would not respond to His accusers</p>	<p>He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He did not open His mouth. Isaiah 53:7</p>	<p>And while He was being accused by the chief priests and elders, He made no answer. Matthew 27:12</p>
<p>He would be wounded and bruised</p>	<p>But He was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities. The chastisement of our peace was upon Him, and with His stripes we are healed. Isaiah 53:5</p>	<p>Then he released Barabbas for them; but Jesus he scourged and delivered over to be crucified. Matthew 27:26</p>
<p>He would be smitten and spit upon</p>	<p>I gave my back to those who strike me, and my cheeks to those who pluck out the beard; I did not cover My face from humiliation and spitting. Isaiah 50:6</p>	<p>Then they spit in His face and struck Him with their fists. Others slapped Him and said, "Prophecy to us, Christ. Who hit you?" Matthew 26:67,68</p>
<p>He would be mocked</p>	<p>All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, he trusted the Lord that He would deliver Him: let Him deliver Him seeing he delighted in Him. Psalms 22:2-8</p>	<p>And after they had mocked Him, they took His robe off and put His garments on Him, and led Him away to crucify Him. Matthew 27:31</p>

His hands and feet would be pierced	They pierced my hands and my feet. Psalm 22:16	And when they came to the place called The Skull, there they crucified Him... Luke 23:33
He made intercession for His persecutors	"..yet He himself bore the sins of many, and interceded for the transgressors." Isaiah 53:12	"Father forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." Luke 23:34
He would be hated by His own people	He was despised and forsaken of men, a man of sorrows, and acquainted grief; and like one from whom men hide their face. He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. Isaiah 53:3	For not even His brothers were believing in Him. Not one of the rulers or Pharisees has believed in Him, has he? John 7:5,48
He would be hated without a cause	Those who hate me without cause are more than the hairs of my head... Psalm 69:4	But they have done this in order they the word may be fulfilled that is written in their Law, "They hated me without a cause." John 15:25
His friends would stand afar off	My loved ones and my friends stand aloof from my plague: And my kinsmen stand afar off. Psalm 38:11	And all His acquaintances and the women who accompanied Him from Galilee, were standing at a distance, seeing these things. Luke 23:49
People shook their heads at Him	I also have become a reproach to them; When they see me, they wag their head. Psalm 109:25	And those who were passing by were hurling abuse at Him, wagging their heads. Matthew 27:39

<p>They divided His garments and cast lots for them</p>	<p>They divided my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots. Psalm 22:18</p>	<p>The soldiers, therefore, when they had crucified Jesus, took His outer garments and made four parts, a part to every soldier and also the tunic; now the tunic was seamless, woven in one piece. They said: "Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it, to decide whose it shall be..." John 19:23,24</p>
<p>He was to suffer thirst</p>	<p>And for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink. Psalm 69:21</p>	<p>After this, Jesus, knowing that all was now finished, said (to fulfill the Scripture), "I thirst". John 19:28</p>
<p>They offered him gall and vinegar to drink</p>	<p>They also gave me gall for my food, and for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink. Psalm 69:21</p>	<p>They gave him wine to drink mingled with gall; and after tasting it, He was unwilling to drink. Matthew 27:34</p>
<p>He cried aloud</p>	<p>"My God, My God, why hast thou forsaken me?" Psalm 22:1</p>	<p>And about the ninth hour, Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, Lama Sabachthani," that is, "My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?" Matthew 27:46</p>
<p>He committed His Spirit</p>	<p>Into thy hands I commit my spirit. Psalm 31:5</p>	<p>And Jesus, crying out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into thy hands I commit My Spirit." Luke 23:46</p>
<p>His bones were not broken</p>	<p>He keeps all his bones, not one of them is broken. Psalm 34:20</p>	<p>...but coming to Jesus, when they saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs. John 19:33</p>
<p>His side was pierced</p>	<p>...they will look on Me whom they have pierced. Zechariah 12:10</p>	<p>...but one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear. John 19:34</p>

<p>And darkness came over the land</p>	<p>"And it will come about in that day" declares the Lord God, "that I shall make the sun go down at noon and make the earth dark in broad daylight. .." Amos 8:9</p>	<p>Now from the sixth hour darkness fell upon all the land until the ninth hour. Matthew 27:45</p>
<p>He was buried in a rich man's tomb</p>	<p>His grave was assigned to be with wicked men, yet with a rich man in His death. Isaiah 53:9</p>	<p>..there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph...and asked for the body of Jesus...and Joseph took the body and wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, and laid it in his own new tomb. Matthew 27:57-60</p>
